The mountains in Scotland's National Parks contain some of our most valued natural heritage assets in the British Isles, with special protection designations for reasons relating to ecology, geomorphology, geology and landscape. **PLEASE**

With a mix of habitats across 2,468 sq miles, our two national parks are home to a vast array of special wildlife such as mountain hares, black grouse, snow bunting, buzzards, golden eagles, osprey, pine martens, wild cats, peregrine falcons, the highly vulnerable Dotterel and not forgetting one of Britain's most threatened species, the magnificent Capercaillie.

Many of these species are dwindling because their habitats have been damaged or lost. The restoration of mountain paths offers people a more defined walking line, reducing the risk of

trampling over our precious upland environment, ensuring that the richness of the habitats and species which live within them remain for many generations to come.

The Outdoor Access Trust for Scotland is in the last few months of a unique 5-year project upgrading and repairing over 125km of mountain paths in Scotland. The Mountains and The People project has to date, repaired over 100km of paths but there are still several more upland paths to And contribute towards our complete and more money needed to achieve
